



Dear Woodbury Residents,

We hope when you read this notice you and your loved ones are staying safe.

***The Refuse Dept. has good news to share:***

***On Monday, Nov. 23<sup>rd</sup> a 30-yard dumpster will be placed behind the Highland Mills Library. This will be available to Town Residents for their clean-up projects in preparation of upcoming Holiday's.***

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Dumpster will be available until it is full.
- You can drop off extra bags of refuse, dried out paint cans, chairs, boxes, sink, sofa, etc. Any items that are safe.
- All glass items must be covered in duct tape with multiple X formations.
  - This is to prevent shattering.
- Do not force extra refuse in the dumpster once it is full.
- Any residents leaving refuse outside the dumpster will be identified via camera and appropriate action will be taken.

**EXCLUSIONS (Items that cannot be dropped off):**

- No Electronics; TV's, Computers, Printers, etc.
- No Hazardous Materials
- No Microwave's
- No Refrigerators
- No Air Conditioners – Freon is not allowed

**IS BULK PICK UP STILL AVAILABLE?**

- Yes, Bulk service is still in effect. We are asking residents to place only one item curbside and call the Refuse Dept. 24 hours in advance.
